AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH Requirements for Initial Chaplaincy Endorsement

The basic requirements for ecclesiastical endorsement may be found in *The Doctrine and Discipline of the African Methodist Episcopal Church* – 2021 (pages 253-254). In summary they are:

- > Itinerant elder in good and regular standing within an annual conference
- > Graduate from an accredited college and accredited theological seminary (Master of Divinity)
- > Completed application

These requirements are realized with the submission of the following:

***** Letter from Presiding Bishop

- o Indicate the applicant is a member of an annual conference in good and regular standing.
- o Indicate the ordination status of the applicant.
- o Recommend the applicant for the intended chaplaincy assignment.
- **Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume**
- **Copy of Ordination Certificates (Deacon and Elder)**
- **Proof of degrees from accredited institutions.** (Official Transcripts or letters from qualifying institutions)
- Type of job supported by the endorsement. An endorsement is not a general affirmation. Applicants should be as specific as possible on the actual or intended category of position.
 - o Federal (VA, Military or Federal Bureau of Prisons)
 - o Non-Federal (CPE, Hospice, Corporate, Hospital, etc)
- ❖ A "Call to Chaplaincy" Personal Statement (one-page only)
- •
- ❖ A Background Check. Less than two years old. A report/letter based on an annual conference administered report is acceptable.
- **Current Photo.** A passport type photo appropriate for inclusion in a directory or file.
- **Reference Letters** (minimum of three)
- ***** Interview

A personal interview with the Endorser and/or a designated group from the Commission on Chaplains. This may be a virtual session.

- **Copy of the last endorsement form** signed by the former Endorsing Agent if applicant was previously endorsed by another agency/denomination.
- ❖ A Certified Copy of Mental Health Assessment results conducted within 90 days of application.
- **❖** Completed Ecclesiastical Endorsement Application & Profile Form

An applicant who fulfills the *basic* requirements (itinerant elder in good standing with a Master of Divinity from an accredited institution, (e.g., ATS) should send a communication to the Endorsing Agent indicating their intention to apply. A file will be established, and the referenced items should be submitted in a timely and orderly manner.
